OUTWOOD POST 16 CENTRE - A LEVEL INFORMATION AND ADVICE EVENING
THURSDAY 22ND NOVEMBER 5.30pm – 8.30pm

I would like to invite you to our annual Outwood Post 16 Centre Information Evening on **Thursday 22nd November, 5.30pm – 8.30pm** and I am pleased to enclose a copy of our Prospectus in preparation for the event. A rooming plan for the evening, including subject specific session times and a floor plan of the Centre will be issued on the evening.

If your son / daughter is considering studying A level qualifications in September 2019 this evening is an essential experience and we hope that you and your son / daughter will be able to attend. The Centre offers over 25 A Level subjects alongside vocational courses in Health & Social Care and ICT.

The minimum entry qualifications to full time A Level study is 5 strong passes at GCSE (9-4 in a 9-1 GCSE) including a grade 4 or above in Maths and / or English. Full A Levels take two years to complete.

The evening will start with a presentation in the Lecture Theatre by Mrs Shea, Head of the Centre, at 5.30pm. Following the presentation there will be subject specific sessions starting at the following times:-

The subject sessions will last around 15 minutes with a 5 minute gap to allow movement from one subject to another. This gives you the opportunity to visit a maximum of 7 subject sessions during the evening. A bell will sound to signify the end of each session.

The Post 16 Centre core team including Learning Managers, Learning Resource Manager, Office/Data Manager and support team will also be available during the evening to answer any questions you may have regarding the application process, 16-19 bursary scheme and any other queries you may have.

Following the Information Evening we will be asking students who are certain of, or are considering having their 6th form experience at Outwood Post 16 Centre, to make provisional subject choices in December.

Please note that we expect to be very busy on the 22nd November and the amount of parking in the Centre car park is extremely limited. When our car park is full please use the Leisure Centre car park that is adjacent to Outwood Academy Valley, thereafter it will have to be on the street parking. If travelling by car it might be useful, therefore, to allow a few extra minutes to get parked.

We look forward to welcoming you to the Centre.
