School Meal Charges from Monday 19th April 2021

We have held prices for two years by reducing costs and careful management. There is an increase of approximately 2% to mirror changes in UIFSM funding that reflects increases in food prices. Meal charges to schools with respect to the service provided by the County Council are as follows:

Global buy back meal charges	Monday 19th April 2021
Pupil paid two course meal	£2.35
UIFSM	£2.34
Pupil premium free meal	£2.34
Adult meal	£2.35
VAT element charged by school to customer	£0.47
Total	£2.82


The catering team focus on fresh and locally produced food to achieve the school food standards. The meals represent excellent value for money for a two-course hot meal.
