17(d)		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physically tired or stressed /anxious/ lack of sleep/ skip meals • Physically may have a feel good factor • Socially may not be able to see friends /children • Socially may make new contacts and new friends • Emotionally may be depressed • Emotionally may be very happy with her success/proud/confident • Emotionally relationships may be strained • Intellectually may feel drained/unable to cope at times • Intellectually may be challenged further to start another business/goal orientated/aspirational • Highly motivated, ambitious • Learning new skills e.g. problem solving • Could miss out on children growing up • High self concept/self esteem/ self image • Promotes independence.
