Y9 Prison Me No Way Programme

On Monday 15th April 2024, all year 9 pupils are going to be participating in an event by the 'No Way Trust' which will complement their Life curriculum.

The purpose of the event is to raise awareness amongst young people about the causes, consequences, penalties and impact of crime. This is to ensure young people know how to stay safe, aspire and become law abiding citizens.

Students will participate in a variety of different workshops including:

- *Choices - Presentation from a current or recent Prisoner from Hatfield Prison in Doncaster
- County lines
- One punch
- Prison van experience and the reality of life in prison
- Knife crime
- Domestic violence
- Northern power
- Red Cross

The timings of the event will run through the normal school day, with pupils starting the first session at 8.25am and finishing at 2.30pm. Pupils will have their normal break and lunch time. All pupils will be in full school uniform for the day and bring their usual full equipment.
